HOME CARE QUESTIONS



1. Will the person you speak with on the phone be doing the assessment and how soon can they come and meet the family?
2. What are the requirements to work for the agency and how extensive are the background checks?
3. How many caregivers do they employ and will you be able to meet the potential caregiver in advance?
4. Do they train back-up caregivers, in case the primary caregiver is unavailable?
5. What is the process if the caregiver is not a good fit?

Home care is personal care from a formal (paid) caregiver that allows an aging loved one to stay in their home safely.

These services often include:

- Assistance with bathing
- Getting dressed
- Meal preparation
- Light cleaning
- Socialization
